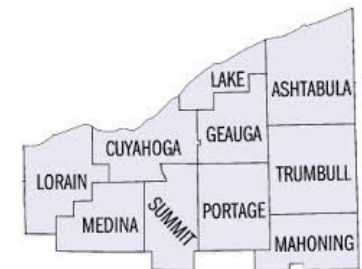

GOAL OF THE SSVF PROGRAM

The Veteran Administration's goal for the SSVF program is to promote housing stability among very low-income veteran individuals and families who reside in or are transitioning to permanent housing.

This goal is met by providing a wide range of supportive services designed to resolve the immediate crisis and promote housing stability.



In order to become eligible for SSVF, the household:

- **Must be a Veteran or member of a family in which the head of household is a Veteran**
- **Must have served active duty and not have been dishonorably discharged**
- **Must be very low-income**
- **Must be literally or imminently homeless**
- **Will become or remain homeless if not for SSVF assistance**

If you do not think you fit the above eligibility requirements, call to inquire about other housing programs and services that you may be eligible for through Family & Community Services. We can also provide you with linkages to other programs in the area.

SSVF

The SSVF program is implemented by Family & Community Services, Inc. in Lorain, Portage, Mahoning, Summit, and Trumbull Counties in Ohio.

SSVF is funded and monitored by the VA and is supported by the county's and the region's Continuums of Care.

The program provides case management, outreach, service coordination, as well as limited financial assistance.
